Analysis of Contact Resistance Change of Embroidered Interconnections Aug 23 2022 Inhaltsangabe:Einleitung: Integration von Elektronik in Textilien ist ein Thema, das zunehmend in den Blickpunkt verschiedener Forschungsinstitute und Unternehmen rückt. Für diese sehr aktuelle

Technik werden allerdings bisher nur herkömmliche Methoden der Verdrahtung verwendet. Um die Beschaffenheit eines Textils nicht zu verändern, und damit den Tragekomfort und das Erscheinungsbild nicht negativ zu beeinflussen, müssen neue Technologien verwendet werden. Ein Ansatz ist die Verwendung von gesticktem, elektrisch leitfähigem Garn. Dieses hat die gleichen mechanischen Eigenschaften wie herkömmliche Garne und stellt damit keinen Fremdkörper in einem Textil dar. Zusätzlich leitet es den elektrischen Strom und kann direkt durch Sticken mit einem elektronischen Modul verbunden werden. Dadurch dient das Garn als elektrischer Leiter für Signale und kann gleichzeitig eine Verbindung zu elektronischen Modulen herstellen. In vorangegangenen Forschungsprojekten wurde die Machbarkeit und Zuverlässigkeit von gestickten Kontakten untersucht. Es hat sich gezeigt, dass das Ankontaktieren und Verbinden von Substraten mit elektrisch leitfähigen Fäden eine mögliche Alternative zu den herkömmlichen Verdrahtungstechniken darstellt. Allerdings zeigten sich starke Schwankungen und auch Ausfälle der gemessenen Kontaktwiderstände während der Zuverlässigkeitstests.
